

Hi, the children are establishing friendships with the children who started this term. The new children are settling in very well. We provide lots of opportunities to enable engagement to take place. It's generally around three years old when children are able to engage in play with others. Before this child will play alongside other children. Activities such as, pass the hat and shake your body will help to encourage familiarity and then play.

Mid- morning carpet time gives the children time to sit and rest. We enjoy this time, where we can sing, talk and share news. We talk about the weather and day of the week.

During the morning we like to make time for ring games, this week we have included, "how are you today" and nursery rhymes such as wind the bobbin up, Tommy thumb and baa baa black sheep, Rhyming songs and stories encourage speech and language in children.
