Glenesk is ideal for a family day out, whether you enjoy walking, eating out, history, or simply viewing beautiful scenery.

### THE RETREAT, GLENESK

Rain or shine, the Retreat is the perfect place to begin a visit. There is parking, toilets and full disabled access throughout. Enjoy a meal or home baking in the licensed tearoom. Friendly staff can help with all tourist enquiries including walking and accommodation.

The well stocked gift shop is full of crafts and souvenirs and there is free wireless internet throughout.

### THE WARMTH OF THE GLEN

The building is heated by a ground-source heat pump which draws warmth from 70 metre boreholes into the underlying granite and circulates the warmth.

### THE GLENESK FOLK MUSEUM

Housed in the Retreat, extensive displays of costumes, artefacts and records tell the story of the glen. Reconstructions of rooms from the 1850s including a children's room with period games and costumes to try - allow the visitor to step back into the past. Ask about ongoing events and activities. There is a charge to visit the museum. You are also welcome to research records and use the computers in our genealogical room.

### THE NATURE PATH

The Retreat recently developed a nature path in the grounds. Leaflets available from reception will guide you safely around the lawns and woods with information about the flora, fauna and features of the gardens.

The Retreat is steadily acquiring outdoor sculptures by artists working in natural materials. Have you seen the stag? The Highland Cow? The otter bench? The grounds also have play equipment for our younger guests!

Dotted around the car park are information boards about landmarks and the natural and social history of Glenesk.


The Retreat is available for booking for conferences, wedding receptions and other occasions by arrangement throughout the year. Catering can be provided and we also have a business room for hire.
