The Fintray Gardening Club: Personal Covid-19 Guidelines

The following guidelines are for Club members taking part in gardening trips and meets, whether organised by the Club or otherwise.

- 1. Provide your name and email address or phone number to the Covid-19 Officer or to a responsible person if the Covid-19 Officer is not present.
- 2. Download the free NHS "Protect Scotland" app on your mobile and switch it on during the meet.
- 3. Club-organised meets may involve up to 30 people, but numbers may be limited and/or split up by the organiser. Informal (i.e. non-club-organised) meets are covered by the 6 x 2 rule (i.e. no more than 6 people from no more than 2 households).
- 4. Club trips do not car share with other households and avoid public transport.
- 5. Physically distance yourself at all times by 2m from anyone not in your own household.
- 6. Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds before leaving and returning home and be cautious of touching surfaces.
- 7. Take your own gardening tools, gloves, sanitiser / soap and face covering.
- 8. Do not share gardening tools or other items.
- 9. Do not share food or drink.
- 10. Take all necessary health and safety precautions.
- 11. If you become unwell during Club meets, you should notify the Covid-19 Officer or responsible person and return home immediately.
