- 7. To confirm the Minutes of the Farringdon Parish Council Meeting 08/03/2022**
The PC confirmed the minutes of the FPC meeting 08/03/2022 and chair JH signed off.
- 8. Planning –**
 - a. 22/0409/FUL Proposal: Erection of a steel clad building.**
Location: Crealy Great Adventure Park Sidmouth Road, Clyst St Mary Exeter EX5 1DR
Applicant : Mr Josh Haywood Crealy Great Adventure Park Sidmouth Road, Clyst St Mary Exeter EX5 1DR
The PC reviewed this application and found it confusing. It is understood it is both a services building for laundry and also accommodation and also storage. The PC queried the requirement for B8 What is its use? Accommodation and a Supply Building? The PC also queried whether the property will be on a septic tank and will they be able to cope with the washing machines. In light of other similar applications which have been refused. Clerk to contact EDDC and request clarification.

b. Appeal Ref: APP/U1105/C/22/3295011 LOCATION: Land at Hill Barton, Sidmouth Road, Clyst St Mary, Exeter EX5 1DR
Location: Land at Hill Barton Sidmouth Road, Clyst St Mary EX5 1DR Applicant: Stuart Partners Ltd Cllr. B Pearce advised of an interest and did not participate. The PC agreed representation should be submitted to the inspectorate strongly supporting the EDDC delegated officer's reasons for refusal 21/2914/FUL on 03/02/22. The proposal is contrary to Strategy 7 (Development in the Countryside), Policy E4 (Rural Diversification), Policy E5 (Small Scale Economic Development in Rural Areas), Policy E7 (Extensions to Existing Employment Sites) of the Adopted East Devon Local Plan 2013-2031, policy Farr6 of the Farringdon Neighbourhood Plan, the Adopted East Devon Villages Plan. The PC also supports the ward councillor E Rylance original comment . Farringdon continues to experience loss of amenity. The lorry park could have been planned in advance within the HB site. The Notice period is perfectly adequate. The sooner the land is returned to its original agricultural condition the better. The illegal lorry park is an appalling eyesore and has severely restricted residents' amenity. The PC agreed this appeal should be dismissed. Clerk to contact all PC councillors for comment . To be ratified at next PC meeting

c. 22/0685/FUL Proposal: Construction of Agricultural Building. Location: Land At Hill Barton Farm (Wood Farm) Farringdon Applicant: Mr Troy Stuart Hill Barton Business Park, Clyst St Mary EX5 1BA
Cllr J Chanot advised of an interest and did not participate. The PC expressed concern re size and amenity impact on residents. Clerk to contact all PC councillors for comment. To be ratified at next PC meeting.

d. 22/0686/MFUL Proposal: Change of use of land for the purposes of parking, associated with the existing operations at Hill Barton Business Park, for a temporary period of 3 years (retrospective application) Location: Hill Barton Business Park EX5 1BA. Applicant: Mr Troy Stuart
Cllr B Pearce advised of an interest and did not participate. The PC confirmed previous comments that this application was in breach of all planning policies and should be refused. Clerk to contact all PC councillors for comment. To be ratified at next PC meeting.

e. Proposed installations at the existing mast site at Spain Lane, Clyst Honiton. This has now been completed and no concerns have been forwarded to the parish council

f. Update on Local Plan no further update on site consultation has been received yet

g. Any other planning related matters none

9. Parish Council Matters

a. Parishioner Concerns-

- Parishioners yet again raised concern regarding height of mounds at HB They are now considerably above the height of the buildings on site and appear way above the permitted 5 metres
Parishioners raised concern regarding the use of Spain Lane by very large vehicles causing untold damage to the road surface of Spain Lane
- Parishioners highlighted the disappearance of a road sign down at Denbow . it was agreed that a notice asking parishioners for information on this should be placed on the ringmaster and the Farringdon Face book page. Clerk to action

b. Update re Air Pollution Services – Cllr J Chanot advised update to be received shortly

c. Improvements to verge at layby- Helen Selby NHO advised that she was the first point of contact. Visibility splays particularly coming out onto the A3052 cannot be planted for safety reasons. If its wildflower planting then there is an initiative for Parishes see link below. If its planters or something else then Helen requires a plan with proposals to review.

WHAT TO DO IN THE EVENT OF A FLOOD

In the event of a flood, there are many authorities available to help. Below outlines who should be contacted for the various types of flooding incidents and emergencies that occur. The local authorities rely on information reported to them to inform any investigations and prioritization of investment. If it is an emergency and there is danger to life as a result of flooding, you should not hesitate to call 999

To report flooding of the highway and blocked drains contact Devon County Council's Highway Customer Service Centre on 0345 155 1004 or visit the Roads and Transport webpage. Office hours are Monday to Friday 8am – 8pm and Saturdays 9am – 1pm. For emergencies outside of these hours call 01392 383329

For any flooding on major trunk roads (the M5, A30, A38, A35 and A303) contact the Highways Agency on 0300 123 5000 (24 hour service)

To report flooding from sewers and water pipes contact South West Water on 0344 346 2020 (24 hour service)

For enquiries about flood warnings contact the Environment Agency's Floodline on 0345 988 1188 (24 hour service)

For general enquiries about Main River or flooding from the sea contact the Environment Agency on 03708 506 506

For all other flooding enquiries contact the Devon County Council Flood Risk Management Team on 0345 155 1015 or email floodrisk@devon.gov.uk

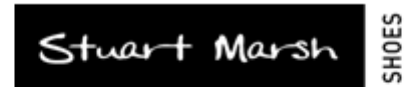
