Weedon Parish Council:

No status report provided by WSA in June/July as the focus has been on Weedon Weekender organisation. However progress has continued to submit the Planning Application at the earliest opportunity.

Lease

No further progress required on lease at this point.

Neighbourhood Planning Group:

Very useful and informative meeting with NP group where WSA were able to present the scheme plans for the Community Sports Changing Facility building.

Further work in the future with regard how the NP group can include this project into the NP report may be required.

Consideration for the amount of sports field provision for the village was highlighted as being under provisioned for current state let alone with proposed new build homes %'s that could affect Weedon. Additional land may need to be looked at under the Community Right to Buy scheme.

The WSA have been invited by the Steering Group to have their stand at the Consultancy Meeting on 20th September

Planning Application preparations

Soil test results now available and indicate that a soakaway is not suitable – working on the alternative drainage options.

A survey of invert levels to existing drainage where the new connections could be effected has taken place. The WSA have also made the PC aware of a surface water manhole situated on the Jubilee adjacent to the new dwelling garden at Bridge St. The outfall of this drain run is unknown

Rework underway for HVAC now that information has been provided from a new consultant who has offered his time probono (thanks to a contact with Church Roof project)

Noise Consultant is now reworking his reports based on new HVAC report received

WSA / WAA Planning Task list items status - planning meeting to begin to draw up and finalise all matters ready for submission is to be planned for September

Flood Risk Report - based on soil report findings the required changes now need to be incorporated into the FRA.

Final scheme drawings 99% complete for planning submission – awaits outcome of soil drainage assessment as this may change the requirement for drainage versus soak away – work to finalise these are to be scheduled for September 2014

Huge amounts of positive feedback, no real issues although a couple of noise complaints but the Environmental Health officer was quite happy with everything, Jubilee Field not subject to any damage and the field left very tidy (no one would have known an event taken place and several people have mentioned this!)

Residents of this village were very proud to be part of this event and have something like this on their doorstep. Already folk are asking for one next year!

Mop up meeting is planned for 8th September.
