Jubilee Field – Proposed Pavilion

This letter is provided by Weedon Bec Parish Council to the Weedon Sports Association for inclusion with the submission to Daventry District Council (planning application) and for funding agencies. This is in order to clarify Weedon Bec Parish Council's involvement in the Weedon Sports Association's project to build a community building to include changing room facilities and activity/meeting rooms on the Jubilee Field, Weedon Bec.

The Parish Council fully supports the development of a new community facility within Weedon Bec and supports the proposals brought forward by Weedon Sports Association. We wish them success through the planning and funding stages. The addition of activity and meeting rooms will provide useful additional space, which will supplement that already available at the Village Hall and around the village, and we envisage that these facilities would be well used.

Jubilee Field is owned by Weedon Bec Parish Council and has been made a 'Field in Trust'. It is a multiuse field open to the public and part of it is leased to the Weedon FC for use as their home ground football pitch. The football pitch has recently seen extensive investment to help improve this facility and invest in its future use. A long term lease will be negotiated for any community centre built at Jubilee Field. The field will continue to remain open to the public at all times.

The community centre will be self-sufficient and be run independently of any Parish Council involvement, including financial input. The Parish Council will support events and activities run at the community centre.

We hope that this letter of support helps Weedon Sports Association progress this proposal.
