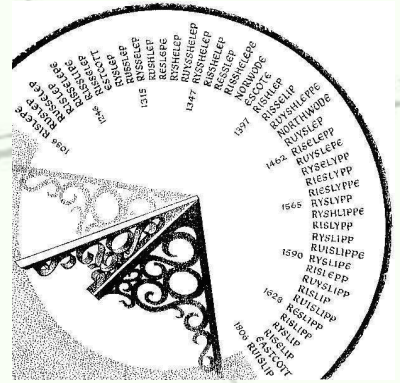

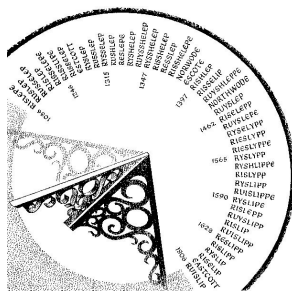
Cover background: Extract from 1897 OS 6 inch map
