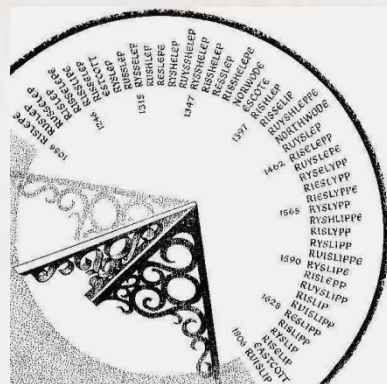

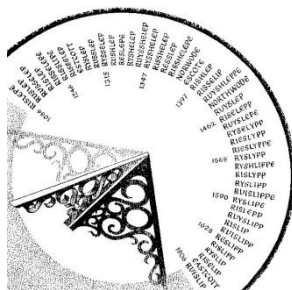
Cover background: The Oaks, Ruislip, 1904
