THE FRANK MULLINEUX AWARD

The annual Frank Mullineux Award celebrates the considerable contribution Frank made to the study of local history throughout his lifetime. The award is given each year in recognition of a significant and original contribution to local history studies.

The research submitted for the award may take various forms such as a publication, essay, exhibition, a photographic survey or other media - anything which promotes or contributes to our understanding of local history.

The winner(s) will be presented with a suitable award of a value specified by the Awards Panel. They will also receive a certificate signed by the Chair of the Salford Local History Forum.

Originally offered for over 40 years by the Eccles and District History Society the award is now administered by the Salford Local History Forum.
